

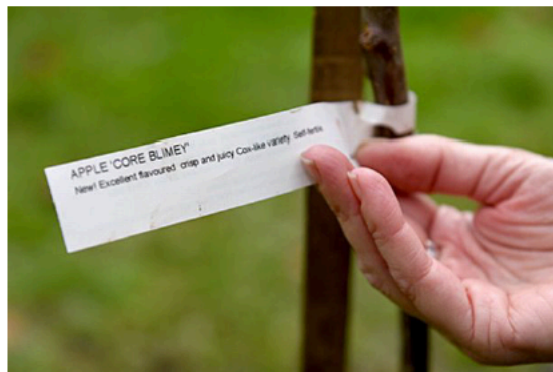


Become a supporter of Queens Park Community Orchard
